WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama has the management and control of the finances of the City of Selma per State Law; and

WHEREAS, the City of Selma, Alabama is entitled to a reimbursement from the "2009 Build America Bond Fund" for payments made by the general fund last fiscal year (2008-2009) for the purchase of the roll-out garbage carts; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Selma City Council to allow the City of Selma's Public Works Department to use a portion of these funds to repair and maintain the department's vehicles & heavy duty equipment due to the depletion of funds of its vehicle repair account (1.6200.126.0) this fiscal year.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELMA, ALABAMA, that one (1) reimbursed payment of TWENTY SEVEN THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE DOLLARS AND THIRTY-EIGHT CENTS (\$27,233.38) from the bond account be used by the City of Selma's Public Works Department to maintain and repair trucks and heavy duty equipment (1.6200.126.0) necessary to carry out garbage collection and other public work's responsibilities through the end of this fiscal year (September 30, 2010).

ADOPTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELMA, ALABAMA, on this the 13th day of July, 2010.




